4. Effective Practice

- 4.1. Did the project change teaching in any way, and if so, how?
- 4.2. How was student progress assessed and tracked in the project? Was this different than before the project?
- 4.3. Would you say the project was about "data-based decision making," and if so, how?

5. Access to technology
