

VIOLATIONS AND RANGE OF ACADEMIC & DISCIPLINARY SANCTIONS

Academic dishonesty includes, but is not limited to, cheating, plagiarism, fabrication of information or citations, facilitation of acts of academic dishonesty by others, unauthorized possession of examination, submitting work of another person or work previously used without informing the instructor, and tampering with the academic work of other students. A full policy statement is contained in Faculty Senate Regulation 49-20 (in *Student Guide to General University Policies and Rules*). Note that a student is held responsible for any specific conditions and standards set by an instructor in a class or course. The minimum outcome is a recommendation to the instructor that a grade of "F" be assigned for the work involved or for the course. The instructor may elect to assign a higher grade. A second offense may result in separation from the University.
