REHABILITATION AND HUMAN SERVICES

The following outline provides a general guideline for students to schedule classes for completing this course of study. It assumes that a first-year student begins in the fall and continues on a fall/spring schedule. However, it is clearly recognized that students may enroll or transfer into this program during any semester. Students at University Park cannot schedule ENGLISH 202 GWS until at least the fifth semester, so they should schedule other General Education selections earlier.
