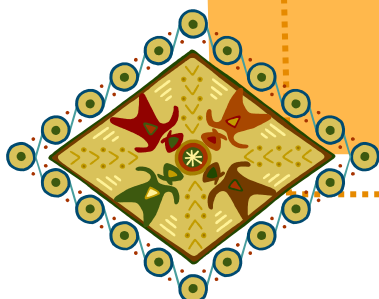


5 Reasons to Become a Member of the DEC
