# Dean's Message



Welcome to the 2007 Annual Report of Penn State's College of Education. It has been a truly remarkable year, and we are building upon an already impressive record of accomplishment. I invite you to explore the descriptions of our progress in this report and welcome your questions and comments.

The College receives generous donations every year from alumni and friends. These gifts allow us to increase the number of students who are receiving scholarship support and to expand important research and outreach programs. My heartfelt thanks go to everyone who shares these gifts with our College. There are so many different faces of giving, and here we feature just three donors who have their own reasons for sharing. The Honor Roll is a testament to how many of you value education.

The College continues to be highly ranked within *U.S. News & World Report* graduate program assessments. For the second year in a row, six of the College's graduate degree programs were ranked in the top 10 nationally. Moreover, nearly all of our programs rose in their respective ranks so that now all of the College of Education graduate programs that are ranked by *U.S. News & World Report* appear at least in the top 15. High rankings like these reflect the strength of the College's faculty members and their research.

Outside recognition of this strength has resulted in a significant increase in external support for research and outreach. Our grants and contracts in 2007 showed another substantial increase over the previous year, and one award in particular warrants special mention. Last summer, the College and its partners were granted a five-year, \$27.3 million contract from NASA to run the Aerospace Education Services Program, which is responsible for NASA's national K-12 education programs. Penn State will now have a leadership position in science education throughout the United States.

The NASA grant is a significant enterprise for the College, and is one of many important College initiatives. Another important endeavor is EDUCATE, a new program where teacher preparation students will harness computing technology for the improvement of teaching and learning in their classrooms. The technology will be incorporated into coursework and student teaching, helping our students learn how to integrate new technologies into their teaching.

We are also actively preparing our strategic plan for the next five years. This planning process is quite timely as we contemplate how recent changes in Pennsylvania Teacher Certification regulations will affect our teacher preparation programs. Our strategic planning process includes study teams set up to review particular areas of the College. As we proceed with strategic planning, we are being careful not to abandon the College's many strengths, but to build on them and keep our eyes open for new opportunities.

On the following pages, you will find the strength of the College represented in charts and graphs. Behind those numbers are the many people who work together to make the College of Education such a success—our faculty, staff, students, alumni, and friends. I hope you enjoy learning more about what we have accomplished in 2007. Thank you again for your support. You can take great pride in what we are accomplishing together as a College.

# Faces of Giving

In the last year, over 4000 people contributed gifts to the College of Education. Our donors represent a variety of experiences, cultures, and interests. They give in different amounts, in different ways, and for different reasons, but they all recognize the value of education. Here we profile just some who have given to the College in the last year.

## Vincent and Lois Lunetta



***“Faculty members can see important needs in their fields of specialization and make a difference in the College. For us, creating the endowed fellowship is an opportunity to serve the community in a different way than in the past. It is an important culmination of our careers.”***

Vincent and Lois Lunetta first came to Penn State in 1987 when Vince joined the College of Education as the associate dean for research and graduate programs. Since that time, both have become vital members of the Penn State community.

The Lunettas both began their careers as science teachers. Vince taught physics while Lois taught biology and chemistry. After teaching for 10 years, Vince earned his doctorate in education and took a position at the University of Iowa. After 15 years in Iowa and time at the National Science Foundation, they relocated to Penn State.

Shortly after arriving in State College, Lois took a part-time position as a program assistant at the Breazeale Nuclear Reactor on the Penn State campus. In this position, she relied on her science education background to help develop curriculum materials and to conduct investigations and tours with visiting students and teachers. Vince served as associate dean for five years, then returned to the faculty and served as a professor in science education for another ten years.

During his career in science education, he mentored many students who moved on to faculty positions throughout the world. In retirement, Vince maintains science education connections through partnerships with former students and colleagues as well as through involvement with the American Association for the Advancement of Science, the National Science Teachers Association, and other professional associations.

Working closely with so many students made Vince aware of the financial hardships many graduate students face. He recognized the need for Ph.D. candidates in education to be well informed about schools and school cultures as well as to be able to develop expertise in diverse educational fields. These realities limit the number of experienced, highly qualified candidates who consider doctoral study in fields like science education. To pursue excellent doctoral programs at an institution like Penn State, well-qualified educators must give up the salary, benefits, and security of teaching and administrative positions, and frequently relocate their families as well.

This awareness inspired the Lunettas to create a Fellowship Endowment in the College of Education following their retirement. They want the fellowship funds to help reduce financial hardship and to serve as an incentive for highly qualified educators to pursue doctoral study in science education at Penn State.

## Glenn and Nancy Gamble

***“It is not difficult to stay involved and give back to the University. Our lives are enriched through volunteering, by the people we get to know and the things we get to do. It is also so much fun to meet and connect with the students who receive our scholarships. They are so appreciative.”***

Glenn and Nancy Gamble have spent a lifetime serving the Penn State Community. Both are Penn State alumni. Glenn holds B.S. ('51) and M.Ed. ('59) degrees in Agricultural Education and a D.Ed. ('59) in Counselor Education; Nancy earned her B.S. ('52) in Home Economics Education and her M.Ed. ('55) in Child Development and Family Relations.

Both had long, extensive careers in education. Glenn was director of university career services and assistant professor of education at Rutgers University from 1961 until his retirement in 1990. Nancy served 30 years in elementary and special education, retiring as an elementary principal.

Although they lived in New Jersey, they spent numerous weekends in State College, supporting Nittany Lion sports and participating in various alumni boards and committees. Glenn was a member of the organizational committee that established Penn State's Alumni Recruitment Program, and he and Nancy were alumni recruitment volunteers for many years. Both were members of the College of Education Alumni Society Board, with Glenn serving as the inaugural president. They have been involved with several other Penn State alumni groups throughout their lives, including the Alumni Council.



Volunteerism is a way of life for the Gambles. They were recognized in 1995 by the Penn State Alumni Association with the Philip Philip Mitchell Alumni Service Award, an award given to those who have contributed generously to the enhancement, growth, development, and improvement of Penn State. Just recently, they received the 2007 Charles Lupton award from the Division of Development and Alumni Relations, in recognition for outstanding volunteer service to the Penn State community.

The Gambles have created five scholarship endowments at Penn State—three in the College of Education, one in the College of Health and Human Development, and one in the College of Arts and Architecture. They have also sponsored performances with the Penn State Center for the Performing Arts over the last three years, and have created an endowment for the performing arts. They have also named the College of Education as a recipient of a Legacy Grant.

## Jenny Scott Lee



***“My parents always talked about the importance of giving back, and so philanthropy has always been in the forefront of my mind. I specifically wanted to give back to the College of Education because***

***my degree has been so instrumental in my success. I wouldn't be here if not for Penn State.”***

When Jenny Scott Lee was 2 weeks old, her dad, Gregg Scott '73 BARCH, who was a Penn State architecture student at the time, took her to a Penn State pep rally before a Penn State-Nebraska Game.

In spite of this early dose of Penn State spirit, Jenny attended a different university for her undergraduate degree in English. At that time, she wanted to attend a smaller school in a big city, but when she decided she wanted to go to graduate school, she wanted to be in a college town. She knew Penn State would be a perfect fit. Jenny earned her master's degree in counselor education from Penn State in 1997.

After finishing her degree, Jenny wanted to work in education, but was not specifically looking for a university position. Two other Penn Staters from her program were working for Datatel, a firm that provides administrative software solutions to colleges and universities, and they invited Jenny to apply. Jenny has been there for 10 years now, and has in turn recruited other Penn State alumni.

Jenny met her husband, Rich, at Datatel. He has become a “Penn Stater in spirit,” and loves to travel with Jenny to State College several weekends each fall to attend Penn State football games. They have two small children, Greg, 2, and Becca, 5 months.

Working full-time with a young family demands nearly all of Jenny's focus and energy, but she still finds time to make a difference at Penn State. She sends an annual gift each year, and takes advantage of her employer's gift-matching program to maximize the value of her gift. In giving, she follows her father's lead. Gregg and his wife Terri have created an endowed scholarship in the College of Arts and Architecture at Penn State.

# Advancement Update – Fall 2007

For the Future: The Campaign for Penn State Students

As many of you may have heard, Penn State is in the leadership gift phase of its third comprehensive campaign. **For the Future: The Campaign for Penn State Students** will be the most ambitious fund-raising effort in Penn State's history and will seek support for these six initiatives.

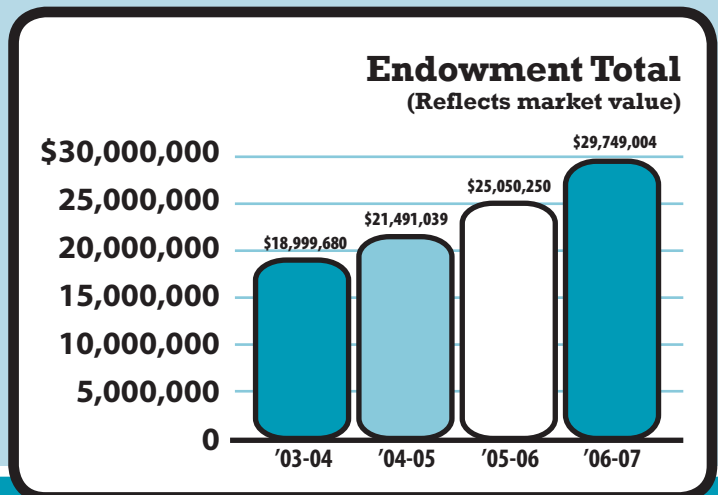
- Ensuring Student Opportunity

- Sustaining a Tradition of Quality

While an overall University goal has not yet been established, the College of Education has set a goal of \$18 million over the next seven years. And as you can see as you read through this report, we're off to a good start. Since July 2006, 15 new endowments have been created, and we had our largest total ever in gifts coming to the College through the Annual Fund. This illustrates the tremendous support we have from alumni and friends who give generously to support students or programs, or make unrestricted gifts to the College.

In an effort to raise awareness of the value of unrestricted giving, the University has established a Future Fund in each of the fund-raising units. These Future Funds are particularly important because they provide flexibility in funding to meet the unforeseeable challenges and exciting opportunities that arise at a university like Penn State. This year the dean has used unrestricted funds to provide Research Initiation Grants to new College of Education faculty members. These funds were also used to support the Arts in Education initiative and to provide support to student-led service projects such as Cyclethon. Gifts to the Future Fund also qualify towards the minimum gift requirements needed for the President's Club.

Through its breadth of programs, the College of Education provides the foundation for all education, at Penn State and beyond. You will find our alumni in elementary and secondary classrooms, in distinguished teaching positions at universities around the world, in leadership positions within school districts and universities, training our country's workforce, creating tools and systems to enhance instruction and performance, and guiding children and adults towards better lives. It all begins here.

Less than ten percent of Penn State's total budget comes from state appropriation. Therefore, philanthropy has become essential to the College's fulfillment of its mission to educate and serve in an increasingly competitive academic marketplace. Many thanks to all of you who have given so generously over this past year. Your philanthropy gives us daily inspiration because you have expressed your care and pride in a very tangible way.

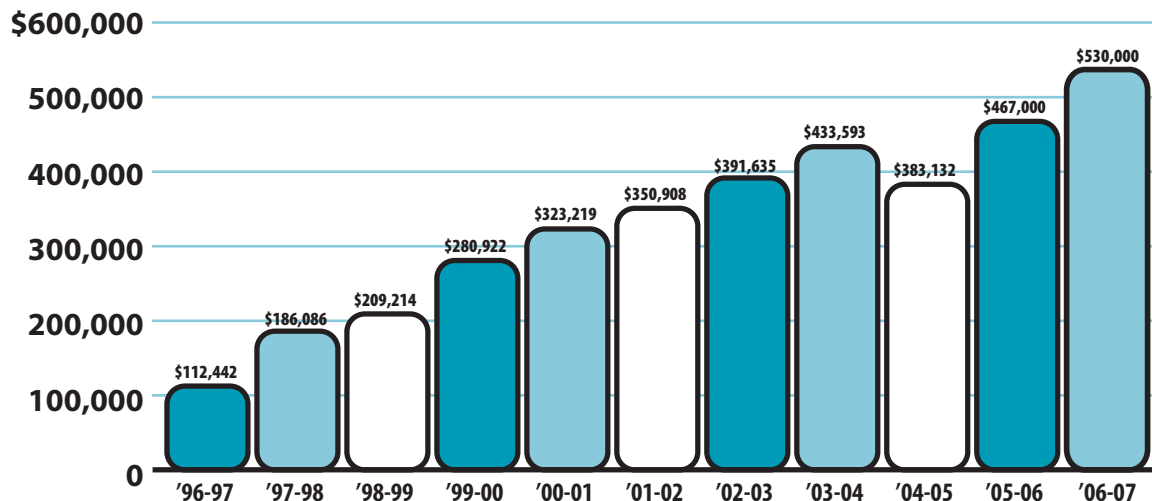
# Funding Students

The mark of a great university is its ability to attract students who have a passion for excellence, motivation, and curiosity. Passionate students contribute to Penn State’s reputation as a top research institution and public university. Scholarship funds are essential to attract such students.

In 2006–07, the College awarded \$530,000 in student scholarships—more than in any previous academic year. These scholarships make it possible for many bright students to attend Penn State with less debt and provide a strong incentive for them to complete their studies.

Penn State’s high reputation also rides on the superiority of its graduate assistants. Each year, the College of Education offers a limited number of graduate assistantships to scholars who teach courses, supervise students, and conduct research. The generous support of our alumni and friends support the tuition reimbursement and competitive stipend for these graduate assistants. Only with that support can we attract the best candidates.

## Scholarships Provided Through Major Gifts to the College of Education 1996–2007



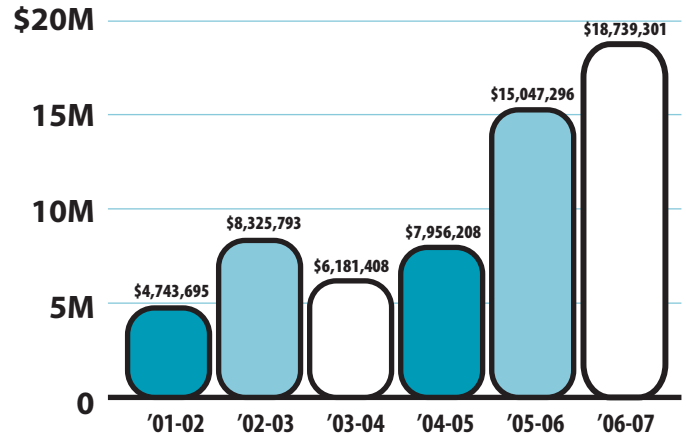
# Research Support

The College continues to increase the amount of funds brought in through research grants and contracts. Most recently, the College was awarded a five-year \$27.3 million grant from NASA to run the Aerospace Education Services Project.

The College's Center for Science and the Schools (CSATS) will manage the NASA contract and plans to shift the existing emphasis from one-time school visits and short teacher seminars to university-based space-oriented summer courses for teachers. School visits will continue, but rather than emphasizing auditorium presentations, NASA education specialists will work closely with teachers and school administrators to infuse cutting-edge science content into extended instructional units.

CSATS will develop and test pilot new courses at Penn State and then, through a subcontract with the National Space Grant Foundation, support the courses at other schools. Education specialists will also collect data on how summer course experiences translate to the classroom and how teachers adapt materials to the various states and schools.

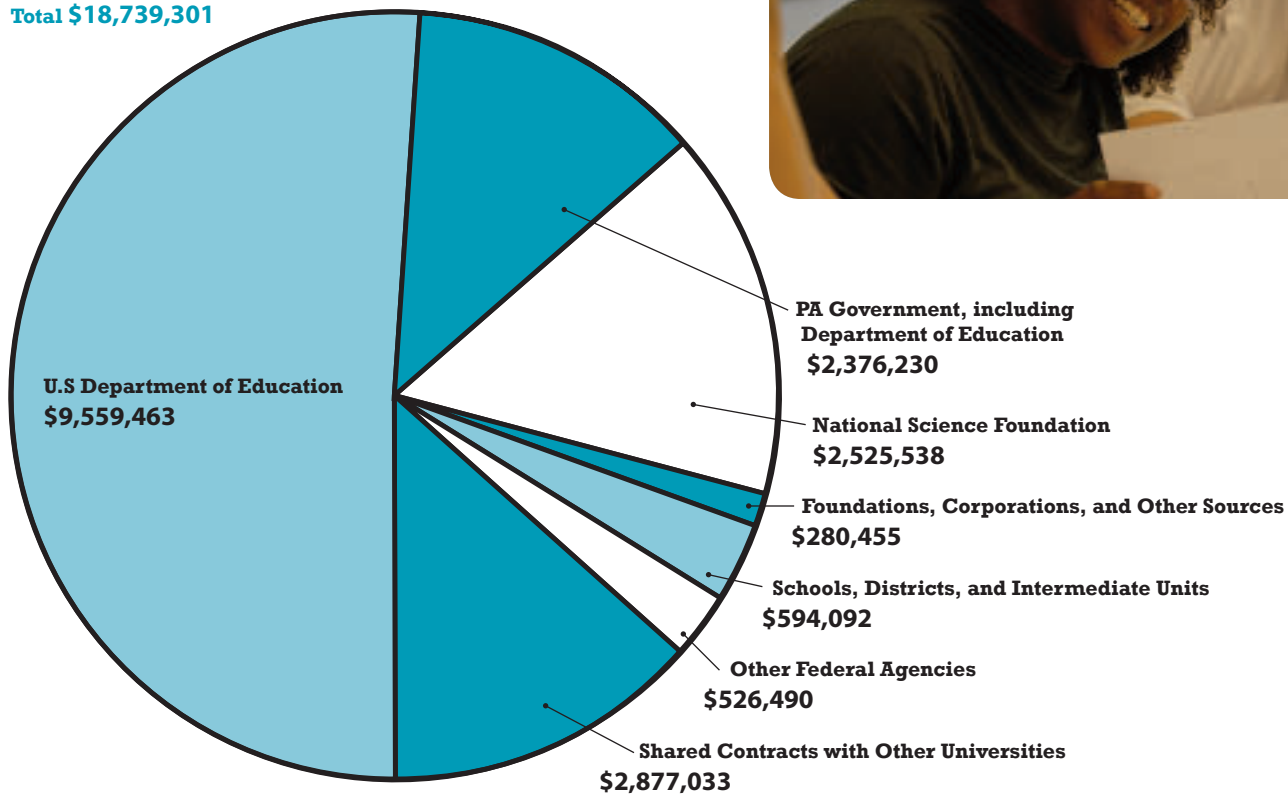
## New Grants and Contracts Awards

Total \$18,739,301



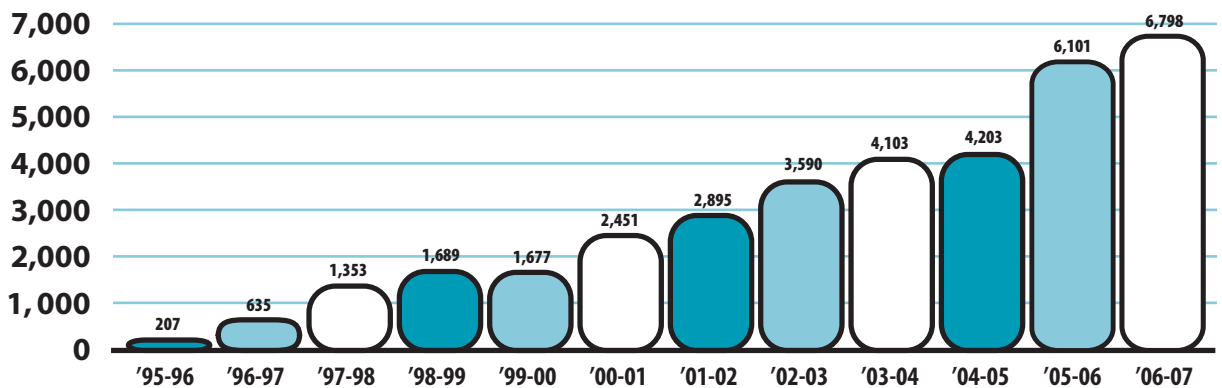
# Outreach and Distance Education



Both traditional and distance education students are taking advantage of the College's numerous resources, which include a number of certificates and degrees offered through Penn State's World Campus. Most recently, the College has announced a new online Special Education Supervisory Certificate program. Upon completion of coursework, students are certified to function as liaisons between public school administrators and certified professional special education staff.

The College has also provided a number of important outreach activities over the last year. The Waterbury Summit on Secondary Education, titled "Re-visioning the American High School for an Engaged Citizenry," last June brought together national scholars, school administrators, and policy makers for a conversation about high school reform. The One-to-One Computing Conference, also held last summer, provided a forum to discuss implementation and policy regarding school, district, and state programs to supply a computer to each student.
