Coach Doherty achieved 100 coaching victories this past season. The 2011-12 season was very special for Women's Lacrosse achieving the best record in seven years at 12-7; earning a berth in the NCAA tournament, finishing the season ranked 11th in the nation; and having two players earn All American Honors and thirteen players earn Big 10 Academic Honors.

Dr. Stan Latta - PIAA Statewide Rules Interpreter for Soccer. Dr. Latta, a veteran at this position, will address the goals, consistence and quality in officiating. He will speak as to how the referee is an extension of the educational process.

Well known across PA, Peg will speak regarding the potential changes in the Title IX legislation and the proposed requirements for district auditing with designated personnel. This is a vital topic at this 40th anniversary of Title IX.
